

# **MAXISWITCH 10A 2 WAY RT CONTROL UNIT**

Congratulations ! You now have the best quality control unit money can buy. Before you switch on any part of the system, please make sure you get the most from the unit by taking a minute to read this important information.

## **Safety Advice**

- This product is intended for switching electrical products with a total load not exceeding 10A.
- Before doing anything with the unit, make sure that the power supply is disconnected.
- Keep away from children, pets and water.
- Never use more than 10 Amps of HID (High Intensity Discharge) lighting with this unit.
- Never tamper with the unit as there are no user serviceable parts inside and this will void the guarantee.
- Do not plug this unit into extensions or adapter sockets.
- After switching off the unit, leave for at least 3 minutes before unplugging it to allow any connected appliances to safely discharge.

## **Installation**

This unit requires two mains sockets next to each other to plug into. Before plugging anything into the control unit, insert the plug labelled 'Mains' into one of the sockets. Plug the timer into the other socket and then insert the plug labelled 'Timer' into the timer.

Referring to the timer's instructions, set the correct time on the timer and it's on/off periods as required.

Plug the appliances into the control unit's sockets.

## **Troubleshooting**

In the event of a timer failure, to check that the control unit is functioning correctly remove the timer from it's socket and insert the plug labelled 'Timer' in its place. Assuming there is power from the socket, the control unit is now on.

If the appliances still do not work, check that they are not at fault by plugging in a known working appliance into the control unit.
